Please note this is not for parent conferences; however, you will be signing up with your student(s) teacher for the Parent Conferences to be held Monday or Tuesday, November 21 or 22. I hope to meet all of you, so please stop by and say hello!

BE A P.T.O. MEMBER AND SCHOOL SUPPORTER! - Parents get involved in your child's school! Be a room mom/dad, work Market Days, help with "Santa's Secret Shop", Taffy Apple Sales, etc., help with both hot lunch and hot dog days. Help wherever and whenever you can. Support our P.T.O. programs and goals. We need your energy and ideas! Please make your child a top priority. Sign up and get involved!!!!

FERNWAY PARENTS - Take some time and review our Parent/Student Handbook with your children. It is important to have the same expectations at home as we have here at school for your child(ren). The first page of the Handbook has a disclaimer stating that you and your child (ren) have gone over the book and understand Fernway's expectations. Please sign and return the disclaimer to your child's classroom teacher.

ATTENDANCE/TARDY - One important goal for your child (ren) is to have him/her at school on time each and every day. You also need to promote regular attendance. If your child is not here on a regular basis he/she is missing important fundamental parts of their education. This school year we will be counting Perfect Attendance and your child(ren) must be here every day in order to receive an award at the end of the school year. Children coming in late or leaving early must be in attendance a minimum of 5 hours that particular day in order not to be counted absent. Tardy students, after 8:00 A.M., must be signed in by their parents. Students who will be absent from school due to vacations will be counted as unexcused.

STUDENTS' ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL - Our crossing guards and supervisory personnel will be on duty to assure your child's safety at 7:50 A.M. Please, do NOT drop children off at the school or allow them to arrive prior to 7:50 A.M. (line up bell). Our doors will open for students at 7:55 A.M. daily (enter bell). Students will not be allowed to enter the building before 7:55 A.M. 8:00 A.M. will be our tardy bell. If your job or other circumstances require you to be out of the area earlier than this, please make other arrangements. Thank you for your cooperation.

STUDENT ABSENCES - Please remember that it is our policy for parents to call our school (349-3810) before 8:00 A.M. on the morning your child is to be absent. Fernway office hours begin at 7:30 A.M. to receive your calls. Should your circumstances require that you need to call earlier than 7:30 A.M., our voice mail is set each evening for you to call into it. Please leave all information such as your child's name and teacher along with the reason for the absence. If you know your child is going to be absent for several days, you can report that at this time and you will not need to call each day. Homework arrangements should be made at this time for students absent more than one day. The absence extension is 4001.

TELEPHONE CALLS (MESSAGES) TO STUDENTS - We will accept phone calls/messages for your child only under extreme circumstances. The message will then be placed in your child's teacher's mailbox or directly into the teacher's voice mail. This is very disruptive to the classroom and we will not call into the room with these messages. Please be sure that you make all arrangements with your child before they leave for school in the morning.

BICYCLE SAFETY - Children may ride their bikes to school during dry weather. Parents should review bike safety rules with your child. Please use good judgement as to when your child has the ability to operate a bike safely in vehicular traffic.

Children may park and lock their bikes at our racks. We insist that these safety rules be observed.

1. Walking bikes on and off school property.
2. Only one child on a bike.
3. Follow all state safety rules.

Failure to follow these rules will result in the suspension of privilege for using our bike racks.

CAR RIDER UPDATE - Parents will still drop off students on O'Brien Drive. Parents are not to leave their cars. **STAY IN LINE**. The children are to be picked up/dropped off at the sidewalk. Remember to pull up as far as possible. Be patient! Remember **SAFETY OF OUR STUDENTS IS OUR MAIN CONCERN**. The 88th Avenue school parking lot is closed both before and after school with no exceptions. We will be having our staff out both before and after school to supervise the safe arrival and departure of our students. There is **NO PARKING** on O'Brien Drive during school hours. This will allow for a better flow of traffic. Try to car pool if you can or walk or have your children ride bicycles. **Safety is our main concern. If you park in the O'Brien lot, you must walk your children to the sidewalk using the crosswalk.**

FAMILY SCHEDULE - Please set up study times and family times when reading or some other activity is encouraged. Turn off the T.V. and turn on learning or family discussions. Reading is fundamental in all learning and the better reader you are the better learner you will be in all aspects of your life.

READ! READ! READ! **Read** to your children - have them read to you. Read, Read, Read! Buy books as gifts, share them, swap them. Enjoy them. Reading is the key to knowledge and opens a world that only words and ideas can convey.

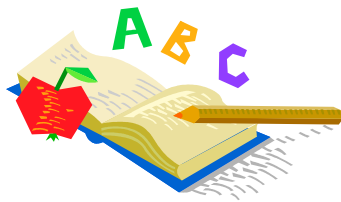

INFORMATION-IMPORTANT –
PLEASE READ!

All students received their Hot Lunch order forms in their PTO packets that were distributed during Fernway's Open House on August 23rd. **Please DO NOT DISCARD these Hot Lunch order forms, as they will be the ONLY COPY your student will receive. The forms WILL NOT be distributed during the first week of school.** There will be five order forms this year-Hot Dog Day, Ice Cream Day, Pizza Day, Special Lunch Day, and Pop. **ALL HOT LUNCH FORMS ARE DUE BACK TO THE CLASSROOM TEACHER BY 2:00 PM ON FRIDAY, August 26th. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS AND NO LATE ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

PARENTS - Please read all the instructions and fill out the forms completely and carefully in ink only. **The PTO cannot accept Hot Lunch forms that are completed by the students.** Please add the totals from each form and include payment in cash or check made payable to the **FERNWAY PTO**, with your student's completed forms in an envelope marked with **your student's name, room number, and Hot Lunch**. These forms are for the first half of the school year. **THIS IS YOUR ONLY OPPORTUNITY TO ORDER LUNCHES FOR THE FIRST HALF OF THE SCHOOL YEAR.** The PTO cannot accept new orders on the day of the lunch. Hot dogs are ordered for five months, from September through January. Pizza is ordered for four months, from October through January. Special Lunch is ordered for five months, from September through January. Ice Cream is on Wednesdays and is ordered for 15 weeks from September 21st. through January 18th. Pop is ordered for four or five months according to the type of Hot Lunch. Hot Lunch forms for the second half of the school year will be sent home with your student in January. Non-Sufficient Funds Checks (NSF) Reminder

Just a reminder- it has become necessary for the Fernway PTO to charge a \$4.50 fee for any non-sufficient funds checks that are returned to the PTO by your bank. You will be notified by the school's office once this fee has been assessed.

Safety is Fernway's Priority

Mrs. Novak's number one concern is safety during the arrival and dismissal of the children. Please remember to drive all the way up the driveway before children enter or exit your vehicle. The children should enter or exit your vehicle on the **SIDEWALK SIDE ONLY**. There is always staff available outside to assist you. It is unlawful to talk on your cell phone in a school zone. Please keep in mind that these are our children and safety should also be your number one concern.
