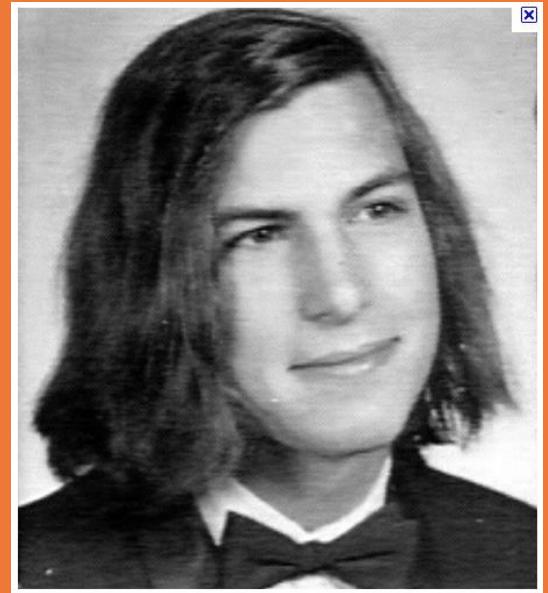
Intramurals
