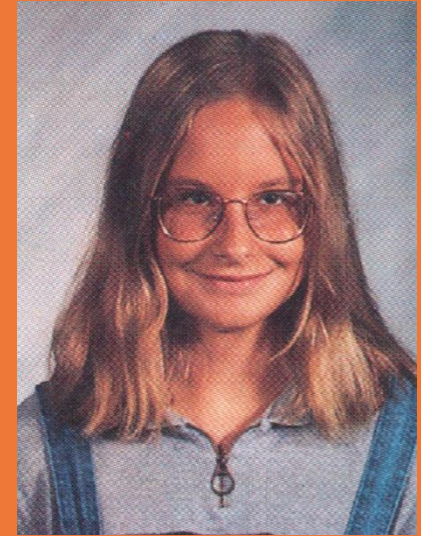


# On This Day in History

- 1767 - The Mason-Dixon line was agreed upon. It was the boundary between Maryland and Pennsylvania.
- 1842 - Samuel Finley Breese Morse laid his first telegraph cable.
- 1867 - The U.S. took formal possession of Alaska from Russia. The land was purchased for a total of \$7 million dollars (2 cents per acre).
- 1892 - The first long-distance telephone line between Chicago and New York City was opened.
- 1961 - "Le Bateau," a painting by French artist Henri Matisse, went on display at New York's Museum of Modern Art. Forty-six days later, it was learned that it had been hanging upside down the entire time.

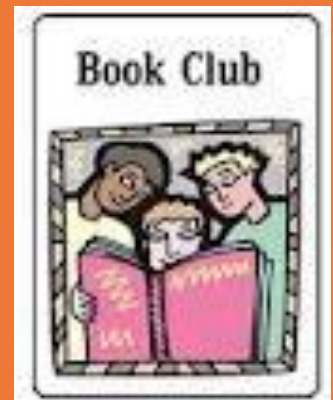
