Definition: "the process of making less in amount or extent"

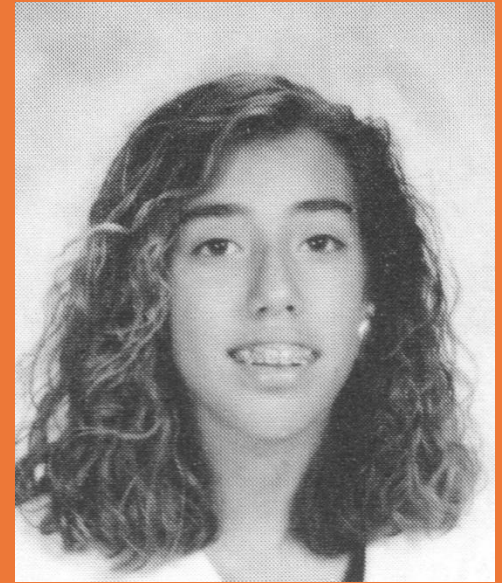
"There has been a slight reduction in gasoline prices over the last few weeks."

- 1945 - Women in France were allowed to vote for the first time.
