Definition: "able to handle; competent"

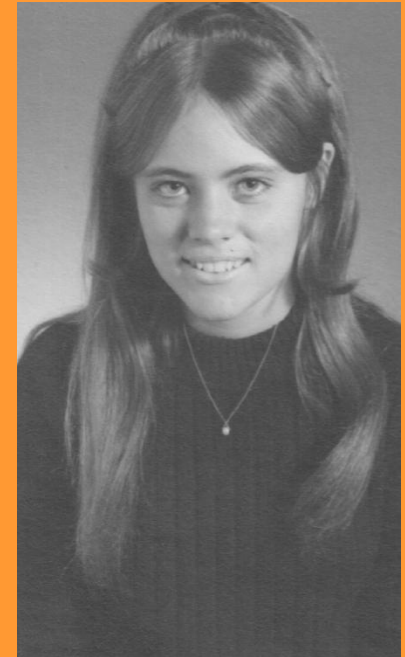
