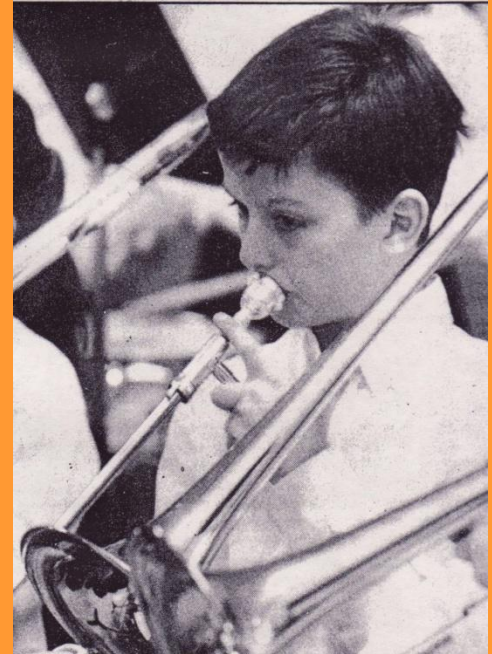
1969 - "Sesame Street" made its debut on PBS.

In honor of Veteran's Day, we are asking students and staff to bring in photos of family members who are serving, or have served in the military. We will use them for a display in the Commons.

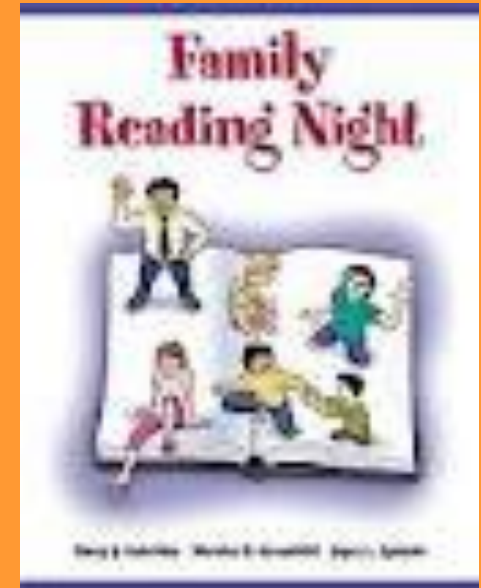
