- 1520 - Portuguese navigator Ferdinand Magellan reached the Pacific Ocean after passing through the South American strait that later was named for him. He was the first European to sail the Pacific from the east.
- 1925 - The Grand Ole Opry made its radio debut on station WSM.
- 1963 - President Lyndon Johnson announced that Cape Canaveral would be renamed Cape Kennedy.
- 1964 - The U.S. launched the space probe "Mariner IV" from Cape Kennedy on a course set for Mars.
- 1995 - U.S. President Clinton signed a \$6 billion road bill that ended the federal 55 mph speed limit.
