

Next bowling is Wednesday, Dec. 7th. Look for session #2 bowling dates and permission slips in the near future.




Make sure you have your hours in by today to be eligible for the Ice-Cream Social. Hours will be tallied by 12-9 and invitations will be handed out the week of December 12.
