On This Day in History

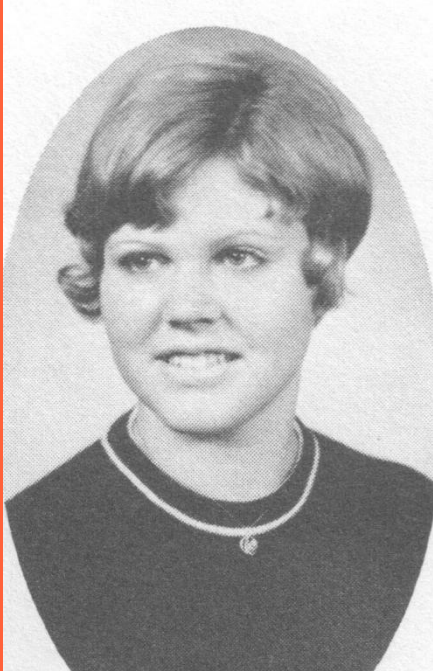
