"We checked the barometer often when we were told a severe storm was approaching."

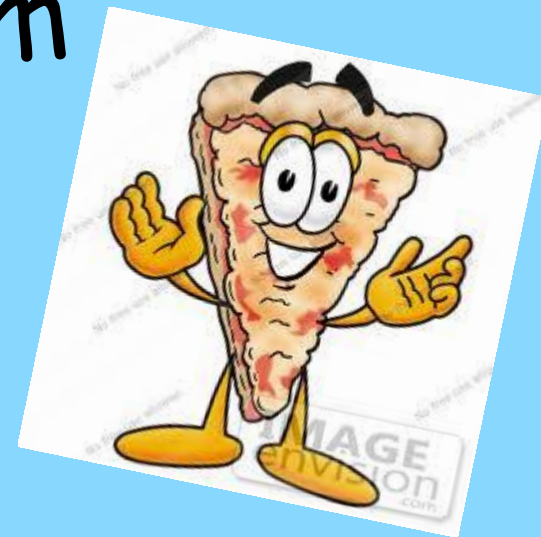
On This Day in History

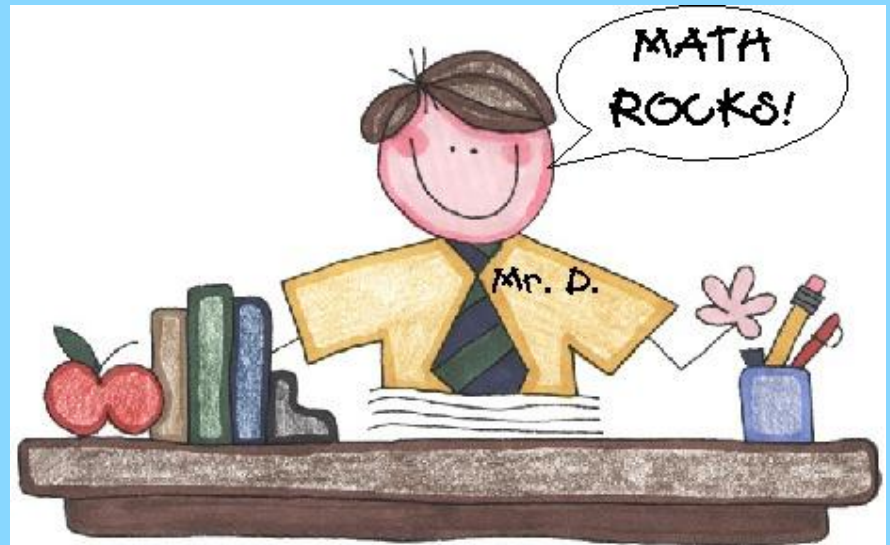

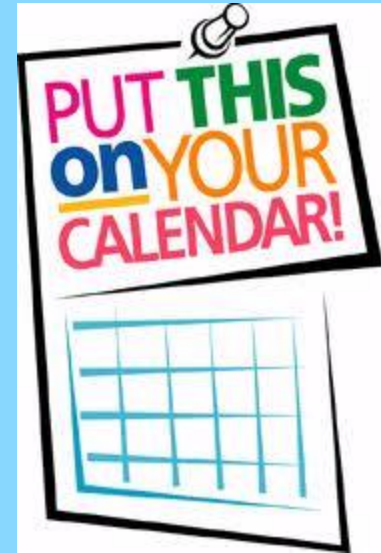
