1926 - The NFL adopted a rule that made players ineligible for competition until their college class graduated.

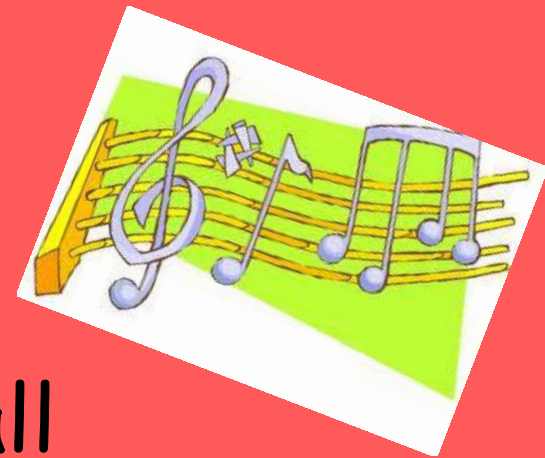
1932 - Dogsled racing happened for the first time in Olympic competition.

1971 - NASA astronaut Alan B. Shepard used a six-iron that he had brought inside his spacecraft and swung at three golf balls on the surface of the moon.

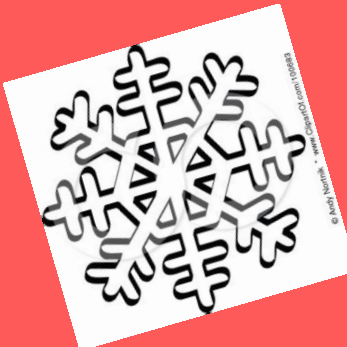
# Chorus Solo and Ensemble Participants

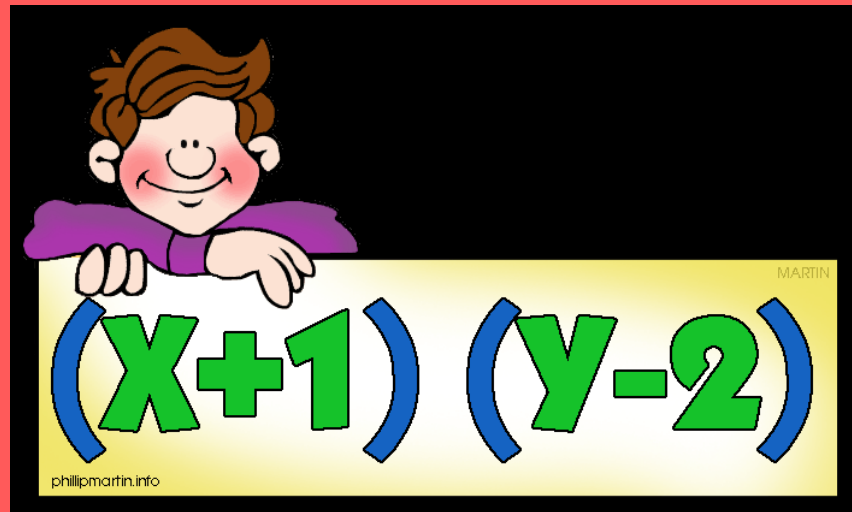
