Definition: "measurement of the quantity of heat"

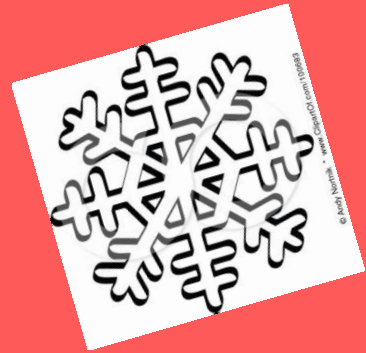
"Calorimetry is used to determine the heat released or absorbed in a chemical reaction."

On This Day in History

- 1893 - Elisha Gray patented a machine called the telautograph. It automatically signed autographs to documents.
- 1943 - The U.S. government announced that shoe rationing would go into effect in two days.
- 1962 - The U.S. government banned all Cuban imports and re-exports of U.S. products to Cuba from other countries.
- 1974 - The nation of Grenada gained independence from Britain.
- 1984 - Space shuttle astronauts Bruce McCandless II and Robert L. Stewart made the first un-tethered space walk.

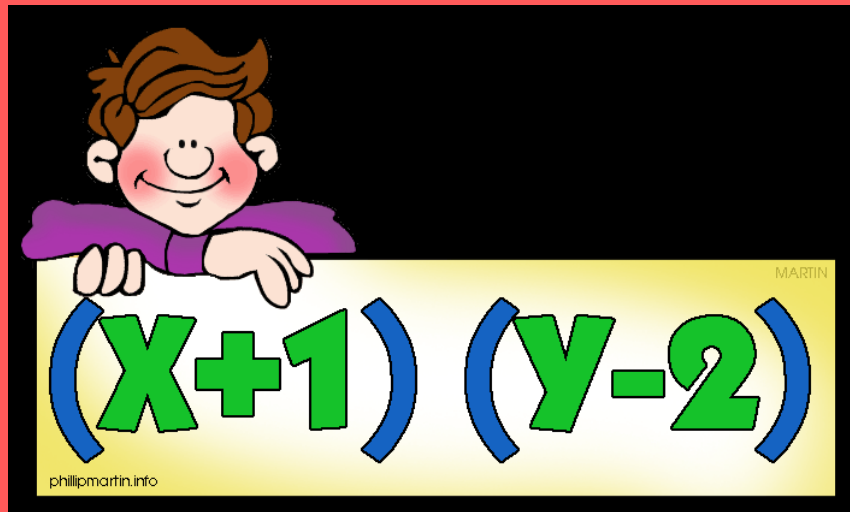
