## Reading/Language Arts

### How can I view my textbook pages online?

1. Log on to [thinkcentral.com](http://thinkcentral.com)
2. Click on the **Reading & Language Arts** tab on the left side of the screen.
3. Select the **Houghton Mifflin Harcourt JOURNEYS** icon
4. Select a state (IL)
5. Select a district (Kirby School District 140, Tinley Park 60477)
6. Select a school (Bannes, Fernway, Keller, McAuliffe, or Millennium)
7. Type in your **user name**. Your user name is your firstnamelastname, no capital letters, no spaces, no dashes (example: michaelsmith).
8. Type in the **password** that was given to you by your reading/language arts teacher.

9. Select the **My Library** icon.
10. Select the Journey's material you wish to review.
