
IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

At the end of the 2008-2009 school year, we initiated a new arrival and dismissal procedures on the west side of Grissom Middle School. This procedure has been very effective and will continue this school year. Barricades will be put out on Grissom Drive to create a "Do Not Enter Going South" from 8:15a.m. – 8:35a.m. and again from 2:50p.m. – 3:10p.m.

- Yellow paint at the curb-side indicates **NO** stopping, standing or dropping off of students in the morning or after school.
- A stop sign has been installed at 169th Street at Grissom Drive.
- The preferred route for dropping off and picking up students is:
- **Northbound on Grissom Drive from 171st Street to 169th Street.**
- **Drop off and pick up your students on the right hand side of the street or the east curb.**
- **You may then turn either east or west on 169th Street.**
- **An additional recommended route for drop off or pick up of students is on the south side of 169th Street only.**
- **Do not drop off or pick up students on the north side of 169th Street by the condos.**
- **The Administration Parking Lot exit needs to be clear of cars so that cars may proceed north or south.**
- **Students are to cross the street at the crosswalk only.**
- **Students should not cross "in the middle of the street".**
- **Do not drop off or pick up students in the Grissom parking lot when buses are present.**
- **The Grissom office is authorized to issue a handicap parking lot permit for your convenience if your student needs special accommodations.**
- **Please refer to the diagram on the reverse side of this notice.**
- **There will be enforcement activity by the Tinley Park Police Department.**
