NOTICE REGARDING REQUIRED HEALTH INFORMATION

Dear Parent:

The General Assembly of the State of Illinois has amended the School Code Section 27-8.1 to include the following information.

Required for school entry:

Early Childhood and Project Pro students are required to have a school physical examination.

Kindergarten students are required to have a school physical examination and an eye examination.

6th Grade students are required to have a school physical examination.

Any student **enrolling in a public school in Illinois for the first time** must have an eye examination.

Required by May 15th of the school year:

Kindergarten students are required to have a dental examination.

2nd Grade students are required to have a dental examination.

6th Grade students are required to have a dental examination.

It is very important that the parent completes and signs the Medical History portion of the physical form.

Illinois School Code requirements are as follows:

The School Nurse will assist the parent in evaluating your child’s health forms.

Any student who does not present proof of having had either the required immunizations or physical examination by October 15th of the school term for which such was required or within thirty (30) days of enrollment should enrollment occur after the start of the said school term, may be excluded from school until such time as proof of the required health information is presented.

Out of state physical forms are only accepted for students transferring into Illinois schools for the first time. The physical must have been completed within one year prior to the date of entry into an Illinois school. The physical form must cover all “required” elements as listed on the Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form (Revised 12/11).
