#1 Third, fourth, and fifth Grade students will continue to meet the State average in Reading.

Results: A majority of the students in third, fourth, and fifth grade continue to maintain scores at or above the State average for reading.

#2 Fifth Grade students will improve their scores in the area of writing.

Results: 51% of fifth grade students met or exceeded the state average for writing

#3 Third, fourth, fifth Grade students will continue to maintain scores above the state average for math.

Results: A majority of the students in third, fourth, and fifth grade continue to maintain scores at or above the state average for math.

#4 Fourth Grade students will continue to maintain scores above state average in science.

Results: A majority of the students in fourth grade met or exceeded the state average for science.

Rationale for Goal: 2009 ISAT scores show need for improvement.

Rationale for Goal: Basic reading skills learned through experience with our reading series, information literacy, the RTI process, Reading 180, Roving Reading, and more class time devoted to reading instruction.

#3 Third, Fourth, and Fifth Grade students will continue to maintain scores above the State average for math.

Rationale for Goal: Basic math skills learned through experiences with Everyday Math and school wide math facts incentives program help build a solid math foundation at Fernway.

#4 Fourth Grade students will continue to maintain scores above the state average in science.

Rationale for Goal: Teachers will provide a variety of opportunities to enhance the students' knowledge using the newly adopted Foss series.
