2008-2009 School Improvement Goals

1. Grissom Middle School will make adequate yearly progress (AYP) on the ISAT in Math.

Result: As defined by the State of Illinois, students met or exceeded adequate yearly progress (AYP) at all grade levels in math.

7th grade – 80.9%

8th grade – 86.3%
