

Helen Keller Goals 2009-2010

Goal 1: In third, fourth, and fifth grades, students will Meet or Exceed the state average in the in the area of Reading on the ISAT.

Goal 2: In third, fourth, and fifth grade, students will Meet or Exceed the state average in the in the area of Math on the ISAT.

Goal 3: Fully implement Character Counts into all aspects of school community.

2008-2009 ISAT Results

Goal #1:

In third, fourth, and fifth grades, students will Meet or Exceed the state average in the in the area of Reading on the ISAT.

- *The results showed that 78.3% of students at Helen Keller Elementary were in the Meets Standards or Exceeds Standards levels in Grade 3 Reading compared to a state average of 72.2% on the 2008-2009 ISAT.*
- *The results showed that 82.1% of students at Helen Keller Elementary were in the Meets Standards or Exceeds Standards levels in Grade 4 Reading compared to a state average of 73.8 % on the 2008-2009 ISAT.*
- *The results showed that 83 % of students at Helen Keller Elementary were in the Meets Standards or Exceeds Standards levels in Grade 5 Reading compared to a state average of 73.5% on the 2008-2009 ISAT.*

Goal #2:

In third, fourth, and fifth grade, students will Meet or Exceed the state average in the in the area of Math on the ISAT.

- *The results showed that 95.6 % of students at Helen Keller Elementary were in the Meets Standards or Exceeds Standards levels in Grade 3 Math compared to a state average of 85.2% on the 2007-2008 ISAT.*
- *The results showed that 87.5% of students at Helen Keller Elementary were in the Meets Standards or Exceeds Standards levels in Grade 4 Math compared to a state average of 85.7% on the 2007-2008 ISAT.*
- *The results showed that 86.5% of students at Helen Keller Elementary were in the Meets Standards or Exceeds Standards levels in Grade 5 Math compared to a state average of 82.4% on the 2007-2008 ISAT.*

Goal #3:

Increase the use of technology in our curriculum.

- *Promethean Boards were installed in each classroom, allowing students to creatively interact with the curriculum.*
- *United Streaming was purchased and used in all the classrooms along with the P-Boards to help implement the curriculum.*
- *Information Literacy was continued throughout the school year using “The Super Three” and “The Big Six” utilizing the school computer lab.*
- *The school computer labs were utilized by teachers and students at least 80% of the time during school year.*
