Goal #1:

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will continue to make Adequate Yearly Progress in reading as measured by the ISAT.

Result: Goal Met – 86.5% of students in 3rd, 4th, 5th grade met or exceeded the state standard of 70%

Goal #2:

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will continue to make Adequate Yearly Progress in Math as measured by the ISAT.

Result: Goal Met - 96.9% of students in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade met or exceeded the state standard of 70%.

Goal #3:

Millennium 5th grade students will meet state standards in Writing as measured by the ISAT.

Result: Goal Met – 60% of 5th grade students met or exceeded as compared to 55% percent who met or exceeded last year.

Goal #4:

Increase integration of technology in our curriculum.

Result: Goal Met- all classrooms K-5 have Promethean Boards. Teachers use daily and receive ongoing professional development.
