Millennium 2008-09 School Improvement Goals

Goal #1:

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will continue to make Adequate Yearly Progress in Reading as measured by the ISAT.

Goal #2:

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will continue to make Adequate Yearly Progress in Math as measured by the ISAT.

Goal #3:

Millennium 5th grade students will meet state standards in Writing as measured by the ISAT.

Goal #4: Increase integration of technology in our curriculum.

REVIEW: Millennium 2007-08 School Improvement Goals

Goal #1:

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will continue to make Adequate Yearly Progress in **Reading** as measured by the ISAT.

Result: This goal was met. 3rd grade – 83% (highest score in district) met and exceeded the AYP goal of 62.5%. 4th grade – 80% met and exceeded the AYP goal of 62.5%. 5th grade – 82% met and exceeded the AYP goal of 62.5%.

Goal #2:

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will continue to make Adequate Yearly Progress in **Math** as measured by the ISAT.

Result: This goal was met. 3rd grade – 96% met and exceeded. 4th grade – 93% met and exceeded. 5th grade – 80% met and exceeded.

Goal #3:

Millennium students will meet state standards in **Writing** as measured by the ISAT.

Result: The state average was 55%. Our 5th graders scored 55%. The district average was 66%.

Goal #4: Increase integration of technology in our curriculum.

Result: Promethean Boards were piloted in 5 classrooms (four 5th grade teachers and one 4th grade teacher). Other teachers were shown an overview and offered to schedule time to share with pilot teachers. This year, every classroom in the school (k-5) will have interactive white boards. In addition, 2 cross categorical special education rooms, the learning center, and a room that all have access to will have interactive white boards. Teacher evaluation included the integration of technology into lessons.
