- Log in to <http://www.classzone.com/eservices/>
 - Your User Name is **pveagle08**
 - Your Password is **eagles**
 - The McDougall Littell web sites work best in Internet Explorer.
- From the eServices Home Page, click on the textbook title you wish to visit.
 - The Book tab will allow you to view the text online.
 - The Resource Bank tab will allow you to see the resources and handbooks from the end of the text. (The "R" pages)
 - The Dictionary tab will allow you to search for definitions.
- You may also link to McDougal Littell Class Zone at <http://www.classzone.com>
 - Your user name and password are the same as for eServices.
 - To find your current textbook, select "Science Modules", then click on your book.
 - Resource Centers for each chapter link to websites with additional information
 - Visualizations and Simulations provide animated images for concepts from the text.
 - The Content Review will be helpful to prepare for each chapter, or review for a chapter test.
 - Audio Readings will read portions of the text to you.

How can I prepare for a math test or quiz?

1. Take good notes in class, complete your homework and ask questions when you are confused.
2. Look over the notes we take in class. Quiz yourself on homework problems that you got wrong. Can you do them correctly now?
3. Read the section in the book that you are being tested on. Each section gives detailed examples. There are also interactive lessons. Look for the teacher symbol and web codes in your textbook.
4. Complete the odd numbered problems in your textbook and then check your answers in the back of the textbook. All odd numbered answers are given in the back of the book. There is also a practice test for each chapter in the back of the book.
5. Attend a review session if one is being offered.

How do I get to the practice tests on the Prentice Hall website?

1. Go to www.phschool.com. Click on the "Click Here" button under COURSE CONTENT (bottom right corner).
