Beginning September 12, 2011, Student Support Services will be available before and after school for students at Prairie View Middle School.

Morning Support: Monday through Thursday – 7:45 - 8:30 a.m.
Afternoon Support: Monday through Thursday – 3:15 - 4:05 p.m.
*****No Student Support on Fridays*****

This program was developed to assist students with their homework and make-up work. Instructional aides will provide supervision for Student Support Services.

Students attending these services need to make transportation arrangements. It is the responsibility of the students to sign up for the 4:10 p.m. activity bus if necessary. Please remember that only a student who is a current bus rider may elect to take an activity bus. If your student is not riding an activity bus, please make sure that their transportation arrives no later than 4:10 p.m. Prompt arrival at these sessions is also a must. Students attending the morning sessions need to be at Student Support by 7:45 a.m., and students attending the afternoon sessions need to be at Student Support by 3:15 p.m. Student Support Services will be available on half days and START days during the morning session only. Please consult the district calendar for these dates.

This support time is provided to the students as a quiet place to do homework. It is not a one-on-one tutoring session, a place to wait for parents after school, or a place for students to wait to attend an after-school activity. If a child does not have a specific assignment or becomes disruptive to others, that student will be sent to the office and a parent/guardian will be contacted. Continued misuse of this service will result in the child not being allowed to participate in the program.
