- On October 29th, pull your vehicle into Fernway's O'Brian parking lot. The lot will be open starting at 3:15 pm for Trunk-or-Treat cars to set up. Only Trunk or Treat cars will be allowed in this lot. Candy stations must be ready for Trunk-or-Treaters by 4:00 pm. For safety purposes, we will close the O'Brien Drive lot at 3:50. So please arrive before that to set up.
- Decorate your trunk. Unique, fun, and family-oriented designs are encouraged. Wear a costume (if you want)! Go all out! Make the event festive!
- Have your treats ready. All Fernway students are invited to participate and attend!
- If you are not hosting a trunk, but still wish to donate a bag of candy, you can send it in with your student to be dropped off in the school office by October 25th. No homemade treats will be accepted. Thank you!
